	<ul> <li>notice</li> <li>Advise instructors running classes to bring their own equipment</li> <li>All touch points within the centre are cleaned regularly by staff with disinfectant</li> <li>Equipment in pods and pod areas must be cleaned and disinfected after each session</li> <li>Reducing the number of persons in the class area at any one time to comply with the 2-metre (6.5 foot) social distance by taking into account total floorspace as well as likely pinch points and busy areas.</li> </ul>
